experience at with NNPC Kofo Abayomi, Lagos and Paktank Nigeria, before venturing into humanitarian services.

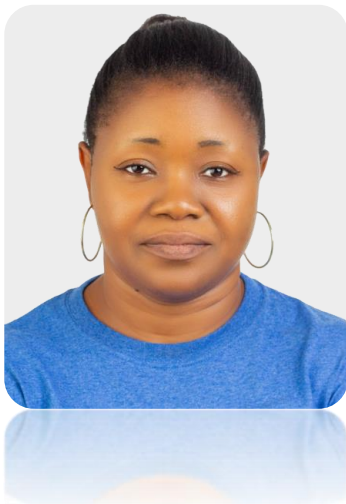

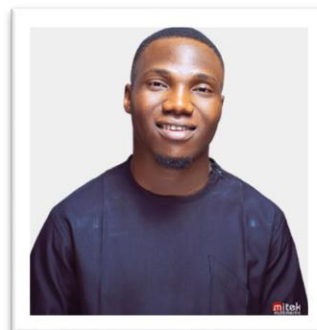

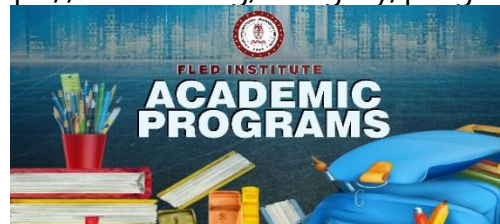
