Living the Value-Based Life

Value creation, value addition, and value derivation: these are what counts in life. Nothing more!

Relationships are sustained by reason of strong value chain. It's a matter of what value are you creating? What value are you adding? What value are you deriving from that relationship or that association?

If you belong to anywhere; a community, a social group, a professional association, a religious group or fellowship, an organization where you're employed, you should use this yardstick to measure yourself!

Always ask yourself: what value is my presence adding to this community, to this organization, to this group or association?

What value am I creating to uplift this community, this group, this organization or this association?

What value am I deriving from this group, this organization, this community of people?

You should always put these questions before you. They are what should help you decide whether you're really relevant or not. You're as relevant to a group, organization or

community as the quality and quantum of value you create and you add. In the same token, that particular organization, group or community is as relevant to your life as the value you derive from being a member or part thereof. Your level of patriotism to your country is inversely proportional to the level of value you derive from your country. That's the way it works.

But there is a difference between value derivation from your country and from any other group relationships you might be into. As a citizen of a country, your country owes you the first responsibility to add value to your life is to reasonable level to stir up deep seated patriotism. Your patriotism becomes a natural response to the value your country has added and is adding to your life. In this case, the gives to you, then you reciprocate by giving back.

But in all the other relationships, you're often the first to add value. Once you voluntarily join a organization or professional group, an association, what should be paramount in your mind is "What value am I going to add here to help the place to grow? Once you come with this mindset and you're focused on it, your relevance in that group will be Outstanding. You will become a person of value, a sort-after, someone who is too important and useful to the sustenance of the group. You are regarded as "valuable", because you add value which makes the group grow strong. While you commit to adding value, you also ask yourself, what value am I deriving from this place? If you are not deriving quality value from that place, you have to reconsider your continued stay within the group.

While you should add value, you should also derive value. That's what makes the relationship rewarding, and that is what sustains the enthusiasm to remain in the group or relationship.

There is what I "value-threshold". This is the minimum level of value you should add and derive from a relationship or group if it is to continue. If this threshold is not met, you can quit the group or the group can expel you or remove you. The reason is simple. Without value addition and value derivation, there is reason or basis to remain in group.

Living a Value-Based Life is what gives your life validity and relevance. The more value you add or you bring to a group, the more relevant you are to the group. What is your value-threshold? Every organization has its own value-threshold by which

it measures the relevance of her members or staff. If you belong to an organization or a group, and you consistently fall below the groups or organization's value-threshold, you will either be sacked, removed, or expelled, depending on which applies.

If your country is not meeting your valuethreshold, you are at liberty to emigrate to wherever you can receive value. If the organization you belong is not meeting your value-threshold, you are at liberty to exit or quit. Similarly, if you are not able to meet the valuethreshold in the group you belong, the group or organization has the right to show you exit door or you locate the exit door yourself and use it.

You will be a joyful person if you decide to live a value-based life. Decide to add value wherever you find yourself. Do it proactively and consistently.

What kind of values should you add?

- *Your time and skill
- *Your ideas and experience
- *Your presence and Network
- * Your money and material possessions
- * And most importantly, your enthusiasm.

Transformational leaders are valued-based. That's the main reason they are outstanding and make positive impacts that transcend generations.



She is on the Committee of Social Affairs, Gender and Women Empowerment in the ECOWAS Parliament, and is a Member of the Standing Committee on Human Rights and Constitutional Affairs as well as chair to the Gender and Children's Welfare Committee in the Gambia National Assembly.

Partnering with organizations such as UNFPA, UNWomen and the International Republican Institute (IRI), Ms. Njai works to help increase the number of women in decision-making positions across Africa.

Believing that women representation is crucial and the fact that only legislation can help bridge the gap of under representation, Ms Njai presented a Constitutional Amendment Bill to enlarge the National Assembly adding 16 extra seats specifically for women.

In executing her passion in empowering women and the youth, and the quest to fight against corruption and promote Good Governance, she founded the Yayi Denton Programme for Youth, Women and Vulnerable People in August 2017.

This is a youth and women empowerment organization focused on skills training and capacity building to help vulnerable populations improve their livelihoods through education and participation in leadership.

Having worked for over 10 years in banking, Ms. Njai has vast experience in both the public and private sector.

A great believer of the rule of Law and respect for democracy, Ms Njai is married with three children and holds a bachelor's degree in Politics and International Relations, a postgraduate diploma in Law, and an MBA.

Late last year, many of us saw a viral video online during budget deliberations on the floor of the Gambian Parliament where a female Parliamentarian express displeasure that members of parliament were increasing salaries and allowance for themselves without considering the welfare of the masses of their people. She spoke so passionately against what she refers as robbing the people.
