### Guest Speaker



**ARCHBISHOP DANIEL OKOH,** hfpl is the President, Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN) and the General Superintendent of Christ Holy Church

Int'l. He is also the Co-Chairman of the Nigeria Interreligious Council (NIREC).

He had served as the Vice-President of Christian Association of Nigeria for two tenures before he was elected the CAN President in July 2022.

From the beginning of his tenure as the President of CAN and the Co-Chairman of NIREC, he adopted a non-confrontational approach of dialogue in making the position of the Christian Community in Nigeria known on issues of national concern while engaging the Government of the day or people of other religions. This approach has gone a long way to reduce the tension between CAN and

Government on one hand and the tension between the two religions in Nigeria on the other hand.

Archbishop Daniel Okoh has been involved in interfaith dialogue and promotion of peaceful co-existence, advocating for inclusivity at both national and international level for over two decades. In 1999, he was the only one appointed to represent Africa in the Committee of Multicultural Ministry by the Mission and Evangelism Team of the World Council of Churches (WCC) to promote inclusivity with emphasis on mutual respect and mutual understanding among Christians of diverse ethnic and racial backgrounds around the globe. As the International Chairman of the Organization of African Instituted Churches (OAIC)- a pan African ecumenical organization with its headquarters in Nairobi, Kenya, Archbishop Daniel Okoh, leads the advocacy on Climate Change and the Preservation

of the rich human environment of Africa among over 70 million members of African Independent Churches (AICs) in the continent.

Archbishop Daniel Chukwudumebi Okoh is part of the leadership of many ecumenical and interreligious organizations and has been given so many Awards of honour in the course of his over 30 years in leadership.

In November 2024, he was conferred with an **Honourary Fellow in Public Leadership** by the Africa Centre for Public in recognition of his sterling leadership service in Africa's religious circles to promote peace and sustainable development.

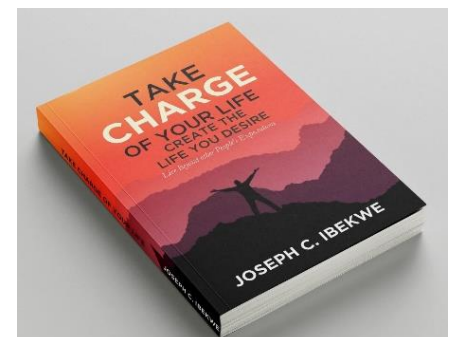
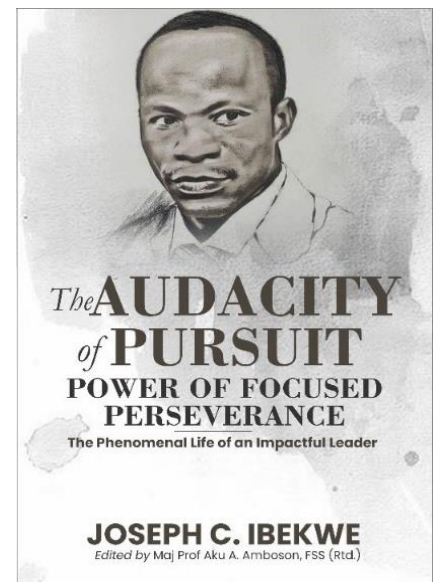
**Joseph Chinenyeze Ibekwe** is an Apostle of Transformational Public Leadership in Africa.

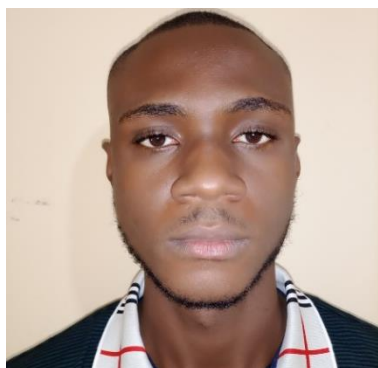

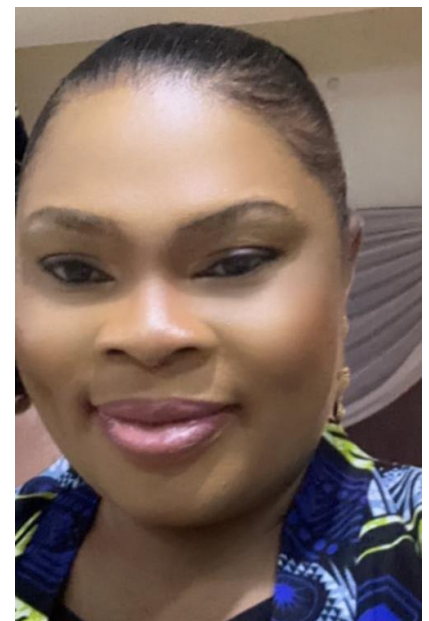
